Description

This scholarship was endowed in 2009 by the late William Evander Mackay of Timaru to support chiropractic students to further or complete their studies who by reason of financial difficulty may not otherwise do so.

Purpose

To encourage students towards post-graduate study in chiropractic related areas, and thereby support the ongoing growth and development of chiropractic in New Zealand.

Eligibility

The applicant must be a New Zealand citizen enrolled in a New Zealand based tertiary programme.

Value

\$6,000. The money will be paid directly to the person supplying the successful application

Mackay Scholarship Regulations and Conditions

1. The scholarship shall be known as the Mackay Scholarship.
2. Each scholarship shall be awarded annually to a New Zealand citizen enrolled full-time in a B. Chiropractic degree or the penultimate year or final year of a B. Chiropractic (Hons) degree or the penultimate year or final year of an honours degree that is chiropractic-related.
3. The programme of study must be a New Zealand based programme.
4. The tenure of the scholarship shall be one year. A successful candidate may apply for a subsequent year.
5. The scholarship shall normally be awarded each year by the New Zealand Chiropractors Association on the recommendation of a Selection Committee, comprising:
The President or nominee
The donor, or donor's representative: The Executive of the New Zealand Chiropractors Association, who under the terms of the bequest have been nominated as the trustees of this trust.
6. In determining the award of the scholarship, the Selection Committee shall take into account the candidate's potential contribution to chiropractic in New Zealand, as evidenced by the application.
7. The scholarship may be held with any other bursary, scholarship or award unless the conditions of the other awards preclude this. However, the holding of any other awards may be taken into account in determining the award of the scholarship.
8. Each scholarship will be paid either quarterly/or upon successful enrolment in the approved course/at the commencement of the course
9. The scholarship may be terminated or suspended at any time by the Trustees on receipt of an adverse report on the academic progress of the scholar. This may occur if the scholarship recipient is not diligently pursuing their programme of study or has failed to comply with any of the terms and conditions on which the scholarship was awarded.
10. Where the scholarship is terminated, the scholar may be required to repay part or all of the scholarship.

11. Once the period of tenure of a scholarship has commenced, Trustees may, at their sole discretion, grant a scholarship recipient a deferment of their scholarship for a period of up-to six months.
12. A scholarship shall be terminated and the corresponding proportion of the scholarship forfeited, if a scholarship recipient ceases to resume the agreed programme of study within one month of the last day of the period of deferment.
13. Conditions of the award of the scholarship may be varied from time to time by the Trustees.
14. Applications for the scholarship are to be made on the application form available from New Zealand Chiropractors' Association.
